You probably already know that Orlando is home to some of the most popular theme parks in the entire world. There is so much to experience—especially at the *Walt Disney World*® Resort, the Universal Orlando Resort™ and the SeaWorld® Orlando—that planning what to do can be quite overwhelming! That's why we're here to help you determine the best parks, attractions and experiences for your family. The sooner you purchase tickets, the more money you can save.

We recommend that most first-time visiting families plan *at least* four days at *Walt Disney World*® Resort (</orlando/walt-disney-world-resort/>) and *at least* three days at Universal Orlando Resort™ (</orlando/universal-orlando-resort/>) (with the coming Universal Volcano Bay (</orlando/universal-volcano-bay/>) water park, families may want to consider adding another day!). Some of our other favorite destinations that we recommend families spend *at least* one day at are SeaWorld® Orlando (</orlando/seaworld-orlando/>), Discovery Cove® (</orlando/discovery-cove/>), LEGOLAND® Florida Resort (</orlando/legoland-florida/>) and Busch Gardens® Tampa Bay (</orlando/busch-gardens-tampa-bay/>).

WHERE TO STAY

When planning your theme park vacation, there is no shortage of options for where to stay in Orlando. With more than 400 hotels as well as vacation home rentals and campgrounds, Orlando has enough accommodation options to suit all needs with regard to budget, location and size. This also can make deciding where to stay a difficult decision. Consider booking a full 365 days in advance if you're visiting during the busiest times for the best availability, especially if you want to stay at the *Walt Disney World*® Resort and the Universal Orlando Resort™.

FLIGHT

Although the best time to book a flight can vary by destination, generally you will find the best deals for domestic flights by booking between three weeks and four months in advance. For summer and busier times, it is recommended you book at least 75 days in advance. International travelers should consider booking at least three months and to a year in advance. Some award flights open 331 days in advance, but every carrier is different. If you are considering booking your flights with award miles or points, determine when the specific carrier award flight windows open.

UNIVERSAL DINING RESERVATIONS



Making dining reservations at the Universal Orlando Resort Tickets is a fairly easy process, although the booking windows vary depending on location and type of dining event. Generally, booking a month in advance for most restaurants should be sufficient.

In-park reservations for table-service restaurants can be made up to 30 days in advance by calling 407-224-FOOD or booking online (<https://www.universalorlando.com/Restaurants/Dining-Reservations.aspx#ThemePark>). Reservations for the The Grinch™ & Friends Character Breakfast at Universal Islands of Adventure, held on select days during the Christmas holidays, do not usually open until early November. On-site Universal Orlando Resort™ hotel reservations can be made up to three months in advance using Open Table (<https://www.opentable.com/s/affiliaterestaurantlist?affiliaterestaurantid=62812&restref=62812>). Booking times for the Universal CityWalk restaurants vary, although some are available through Open Table (<https://www.universalorlando.com/Restaurants/Dining-Reservations.aspx#CityWalk>). Some Universal CityWalk restaurants do not accept online reservations.

DISNEY TICKETS



Purchase your *Walt Disney World*® Resort tickets at least 80 days in advance, so you can link them in My Disney Experience. Generally, you will save more money the earlier you purchase your tickets. As soon as your tickets arrive (or you receive your ticket number), create your My Disney Experience account and link your tickets. If you are staying on-site, verify that your hotel reservation is linked with your account.

CAR RENTAL

It is most convenient to book your Orlando car rental when you purchase your tickets and you have already decided on your travel dates (and booked your flights). DISNEY DINING RESERVATIONS



At 60 days out, you can make advance dining reservations (ADRs) for the *Walt Disney World*® Resort. For the most popular restaurants, or if you are visiting during a busy time, we highly recommend you book as soon as your booking window opens. On-site *Walt Disney World*® Resort hotel guests can book reservations for their entire stay at this time, giving them a jump on booking, which is very advantageous for the most popular restaurants.

In addition to dining reservations, you can also book special experiences such as Savi's Workshop or Droid Depot, where galactic travelers can build their own lightsabers or droids.

Create your My Disney Experience account before making your reservation. If you have a *Walt Disney World*® Resort Hotel reservation, make sure it is linked in your account under "My Reservations and

Tickets."
